Dear Parents and Honor Orchestra Musicians:

The following information will help you to plan for our upcoming Disneyland performance. Please remember to give your classroom teacher your field trip excuse form.

- 7:45 am** Parents drop students off at Woodbury School. Please **do not** use parking lot, as it is reserved for staff only. Meet in the multipurpose room at Woodbury school wearing your concert clothes. Please wear the same concert dress that you wore at the performance. Boys **must** wear a tie.
- 10:00 am** Buses leave for Disneyland
- 12:30 pm** Performance at the Plaza Garden Stage
- 7:00 pm** Return to Woodbury School

**Parents please note: All students must be picked up from Woodbury School no later than 7:00 pm. No Supervision will be provided after 7:00 pm.**

## What to Bring with you:

1. Your instrument and music binder with your name on both. Cello players **must** bring a cello stop.
2. A backpack with your change of clothes, your honor orchestra T-shirt, and comfortable walking shoes,
3. Lunch money and spending money. (No purses will be aloud onto the stage area. Please store purses and wallets in your backpack until after we perform.) Backpacks will not be allowed into the park at any time. Please feel free to bring a snack in your backpack to eat backstage after the performance.
4. Name tags on both your instrument case and backpack. Please label them clearly with your first and last name, address, phone number, and school.

## Disneyland Etiquette:

It is a privilege for us to be invited to perform and enjoy the park amenities. Please adhere to park rules and regulations. Any student found in defiance of any Disney park rules will be sent home immediately. All students must stay with their chaperones at all times. If you choose not to ride an attraction, you must wait at the exit of the ride for your group to re-unite with you.

## Instrument Storage:

All instruments and backpacks will be stored in a large truck that will be humidified and locked securely in a guarded parking lot. No instruments or backpacks will be allowed in the park at any time.
